BUILDING INSPECTOR



JOB SUMMARY: Under general supervision, performs technical duties in enforcing construction codes to ensure public safety and health; serves as a resource and provides information on regulations to property owners, residents, businesses, the general public, and other City departments and divisions.



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade supplemented by one (1) year of experience in inspection or the construction trades, or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Working knowledge of the International Building Code, International Mechanical Code, International Plumbing Code; International Residential Code, and the National Electrical Code; working knowledge of current construction methods, materials, tools and equipment. Ability to read and interpret construction plans and specifications. Ability to detect hazards and violations and recommend corrective measures during field inspection work; ability to enforce regulations with firmness, consistency, tact and courtesy in field inspection work; ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing; ability to remain calm, objective, and impartial under stressful conditions; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, other departments, contractors, and the general public. ICC certified preferred but not required. Selected applicant will be required to successfully complete all ICC certification exams.
